Current members in good standing may borrow library materials through the mail. Item's requested must include the author, title and edition information in order to be processed. The materials are loaned for a period of six weeks. Include your ATTS member number and mailing address to validate your request. Requests will be processed on a first come, first served basis, if a book is currently out you will be put on the waiting list, unless you state otherwise and the materials will be forwarded as soon as available.

The cost of both outgoing and incoming postage and insurance is the responsibility of the member borrowing the materials. Insurance fees are based on the replacement value of the materials, to cover the cost of replacement if the shipment is lost. Materials shall be mailed USPS Library Rate.

The cost of the outgoing postage and insurance must be returned via check or money order with the returned materials. Unpaid charges, failure to return materials or failure to properly insure the return shipments shall result in suspension of membership privileges.

Some of the library materials will not be available for loan due to age and or historical importance. If you wish research to be done that may be requested and photocopies can be provided for the actual cost of material preparation. These requests will be processed and carried out by the editor on a first come, first serve basis.

1. A History and Checklist of Wooden Money, by Emil Di Bella, reprinted from 1964 Numismatic Scrapbook Magazine. The original work was published in 1961. This is an 8 ½" x 11" photocopy of the original work. The book contains listings of wooden money by state and by city. This book contains no values just descriptions. Out of Print, the only original known by the librarian is a copy with the ANA Library.
2. Bilodeau Guide, Ovide Bilodeau, et. Al., sixth edition, Vol. 1, 2003 softbound, bilingual (French and English). Contains a history and price guide for Canadian Tire Coupons. An interesting book, still currently in print.
3. Catalog of Ohio R5 Scratch Marks, Merlin K. Malehorn, October 1989. 26 pages, printed in 8 ½" x 11" comb bound softbound book. Out of print and very scarce.
4. Chits, Chiselers, and Funny Money, Michael G. Pfefferkorn and Jerry F. Schimmel, 243 pages plus appendix of photos, 1977 softbound small format (8" x 5"). Out of Print and getting scarce.
5. Nebraska Trade Token Town Rarity List, George Hosek, 2<sup>nd</sup> Edition, June 1982, 21 pages softbound 8 ½" x 11"). Scarce.

6. Pricelist/Checklist to accompany Chits, Chisellers and Funny Money by the same, 27 pages, 1977 softbound stapled small format. Out of Print and getting scarce, more scarce than the book.
7. Revised Checklist of Wooden Money, by Emil Di Bella, published 1947. This is an 8 ½" x 11" photocopy of the original work. The book contains listings of wooden money by state and by city. This book contains no values just descriptions. Out of Print, the only original known by the librarian is a copy with the ANA Library.
8. Sales Tax Tokens Prices, Jerry F. Schimmel, 12 pages, 1989 softbound, stapled, small format. A book listing all market values for sales tax tokens in three grades, as of 1989. Out of Print, but still available.
9. Specialized Catalogue of U.S. Sales Tax Tokens, by George Magee, Jr., revised edition, November 1936, printed by The Magee Press, Philadelphia PA. 24 pages, white soft cover, small format 4" x 5". Contains a brief history, collecting information, storage information and listings of tokens to include some pricing. Out of Print, the Librarian only knows of three copies that exist, extremely scarce.
10. Supplement sheets for United States Sales Tax Tokens and Stamps: A History and Catalog, there are approximately 70 loose-leaf pages of addenda issued by the club when new discoveries are reported. These are in loose leaf, large format. These are still available from the club through the newsletter.
11. U.S. State-Issued Sales Tax Tokens, Jerry F. Schimmel, 1st edition, 20 pages, June 1973 softbound, stapled, small format. Out of Print, may still be available, rare.
12. U.S. State-Issued Sales Tax Tokens, Jerry F. Schimmel, 2<sup>nd</sup> edition revised, 26 pages, 1980 softbound, stapled, small format. Out of Print, print run of 2000 copies, still available but getting scarce.
13. A Checklist of Sales Tax Tokens, by Emil Di Bella, 1<sup>st</sup> Edition, 1944. Tan soft cover 10 pages without illustrations. Includes listings of "sales tax coupons" from Ohio, provisional issues of Illinois, cardboard and wood issues of Washington, cardboard private issues of California, and others. No values or rarities are given. Out of Print, very scarce.
14. Sales Tax Tokens, by Emil Di Bella, 2<sup>nd</sup> Edition, revised and reprinted from The August 15, 1944 issue of the Numismatic Scrapbook Magazine. Blue/Green soft cover 12 pages with a few photographs. Includes listings of "sales tax coupons" from Ohio, provisional issues of Illinois, cardboard and wood issues of Washington, cardboard private issues of California, and others. No values or rarities are given. Out of Print, very scarce.
15. A Checklist of Sales Tax Tokens, by Emil Di Bella, 3<sup>rd</sup> Edition, revised 1971. Blue soft cover - 16 pages with a few illustrations. Lists unofficial issues. No values or rarities are given. Out of Print, scarce. (3 copies available for loan)
